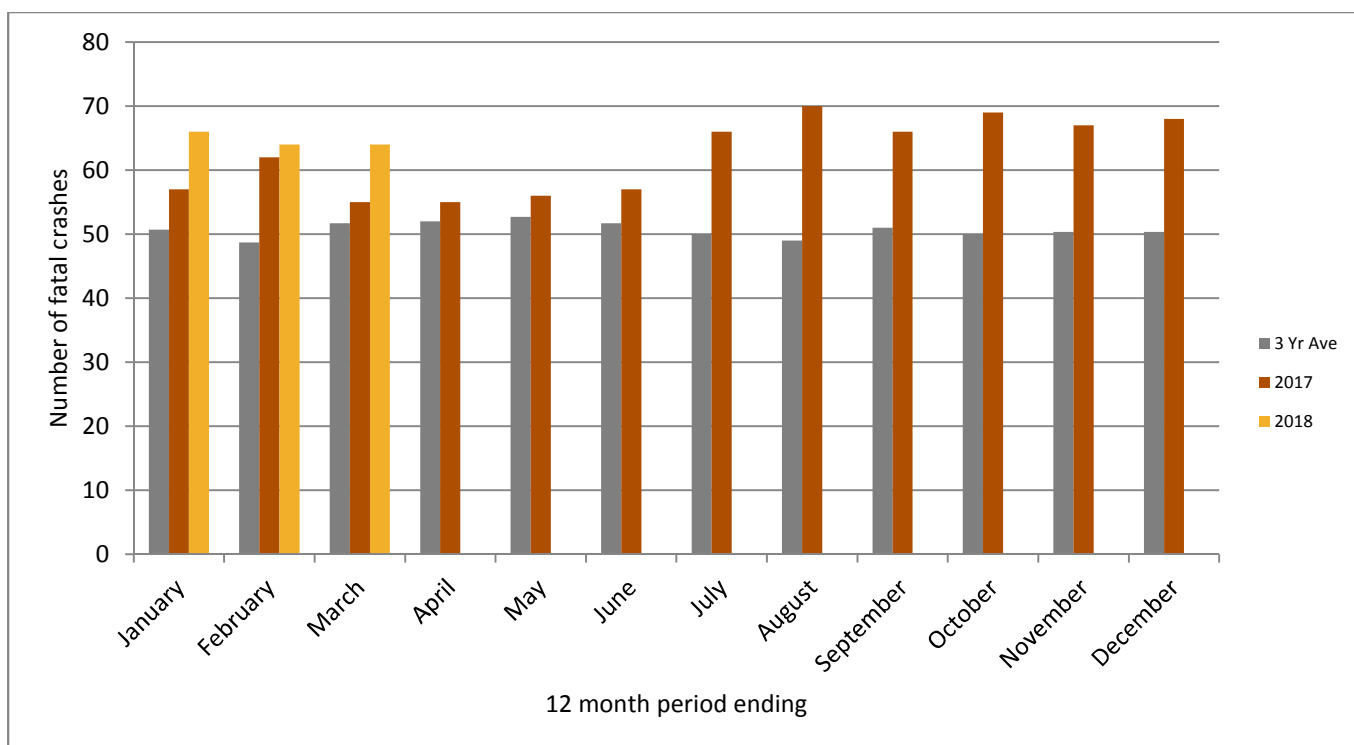


## NSW heavy truck fatal crashes – as at 15 April 2018

### Heavy truck fatal crashes, five years 2012 to 2016

- **260** fatal crashes involving heavy trucks, on average **52** fatal crashes per year
- **289** fatalities from heavy truck crashes, on average **58** people killed per year
- **6937** injuries from heavy truck crashes, on average **1387** injuries per year
- This includes **1993** serious injuries, on average **399** serious injuries per year

## 12 months ending 15 April 2018 v's 2017



- **63** heavy truck fatal crashes, **10** more than the previous 12 months
- **77** fatalities from heavy truck crashes, **17** more than the previous 12 months
- **182** serious injuries (Jan- Jun 2017), **9** serious injuries fewer than previous year (Jan-Jun 2016)

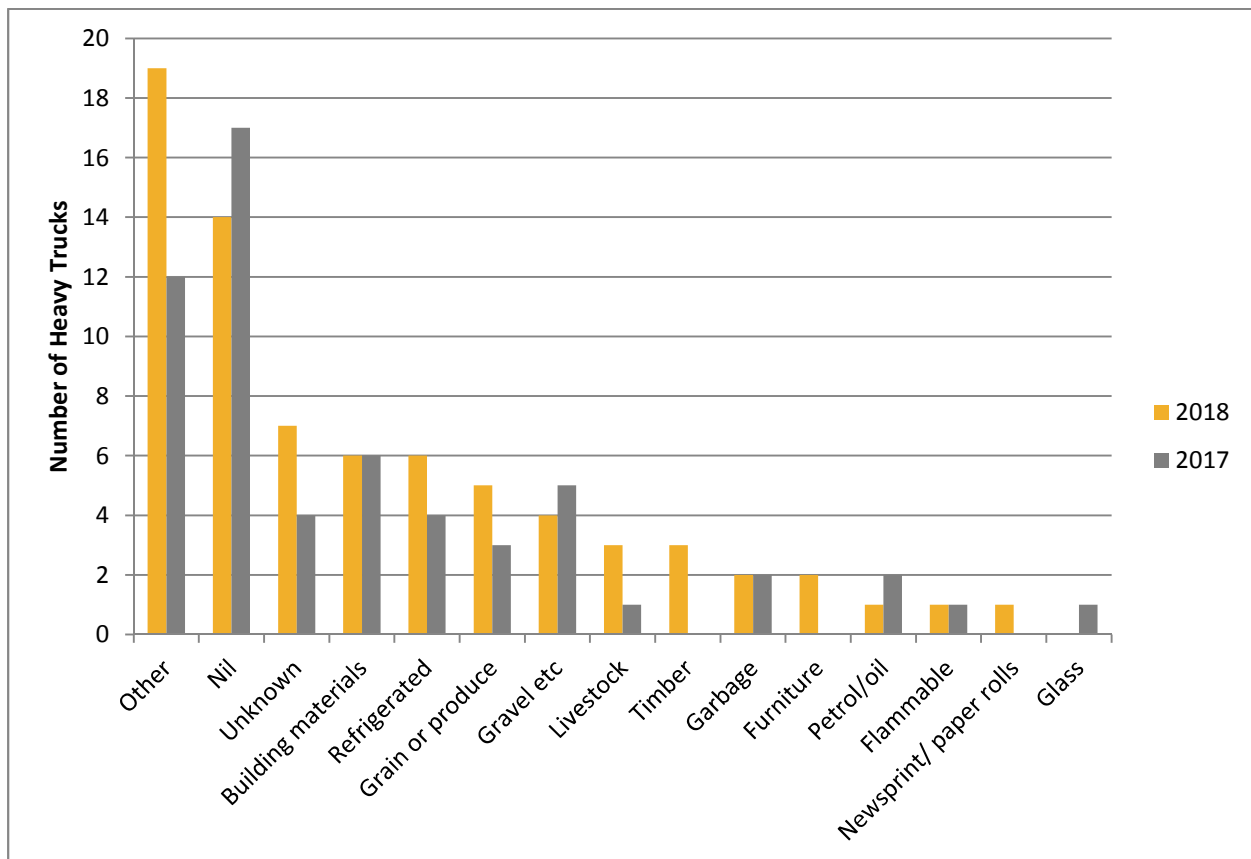

## Definitions

### Heavy Truck Crash

Any crash involving a Heavy Rigid Truck (rigid lorry and rigid tanker with a tare weight in excess of 4.5 tonnes) or an Articulated Truck (articulated tanker, semi-trailer, low loader, road train or B-double) on a road that results in death, injury or towed vehicle and is reported to the police.

### Heavy Truck Fatality

A person who dies within 30 days from injuries received in a heavy truck crash
