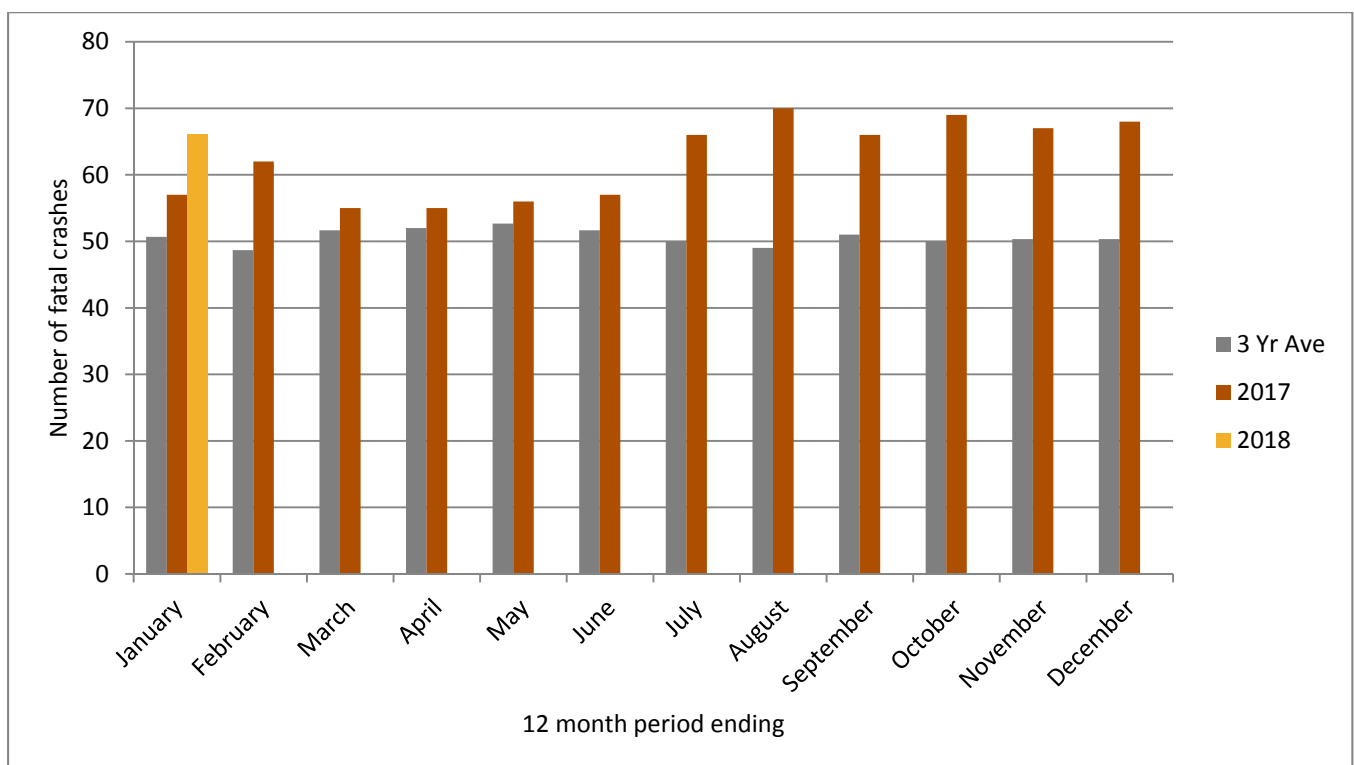


NSW heavy truck fatal crashes – as at 11 February 2018

Heavy truck fatal crashes, five years 2012 to 2016

- **260** fatal crashes involving heavy trucks, on average **52** fatal crashes per year
- **289** fatalities from heavy truck crashes, on average **58** people killed per year
- **6937** injuries from heavy truck crashes, on average **1387** injuries per year
- This includes **1993** serious injuries, on average **399** serious injuries per year

12 months ending 11 February 2018 v's 2017



- **65** heavy truck fatal crashes, **6** more than the previous 12 months
- **79** fatalities from heavy truck crashes, **14** more than the previous 12 months
- **182** serious injuries (Jan- Jun 2017), **9** serious injuries fewer than previous year (Jan-Jun 2016)

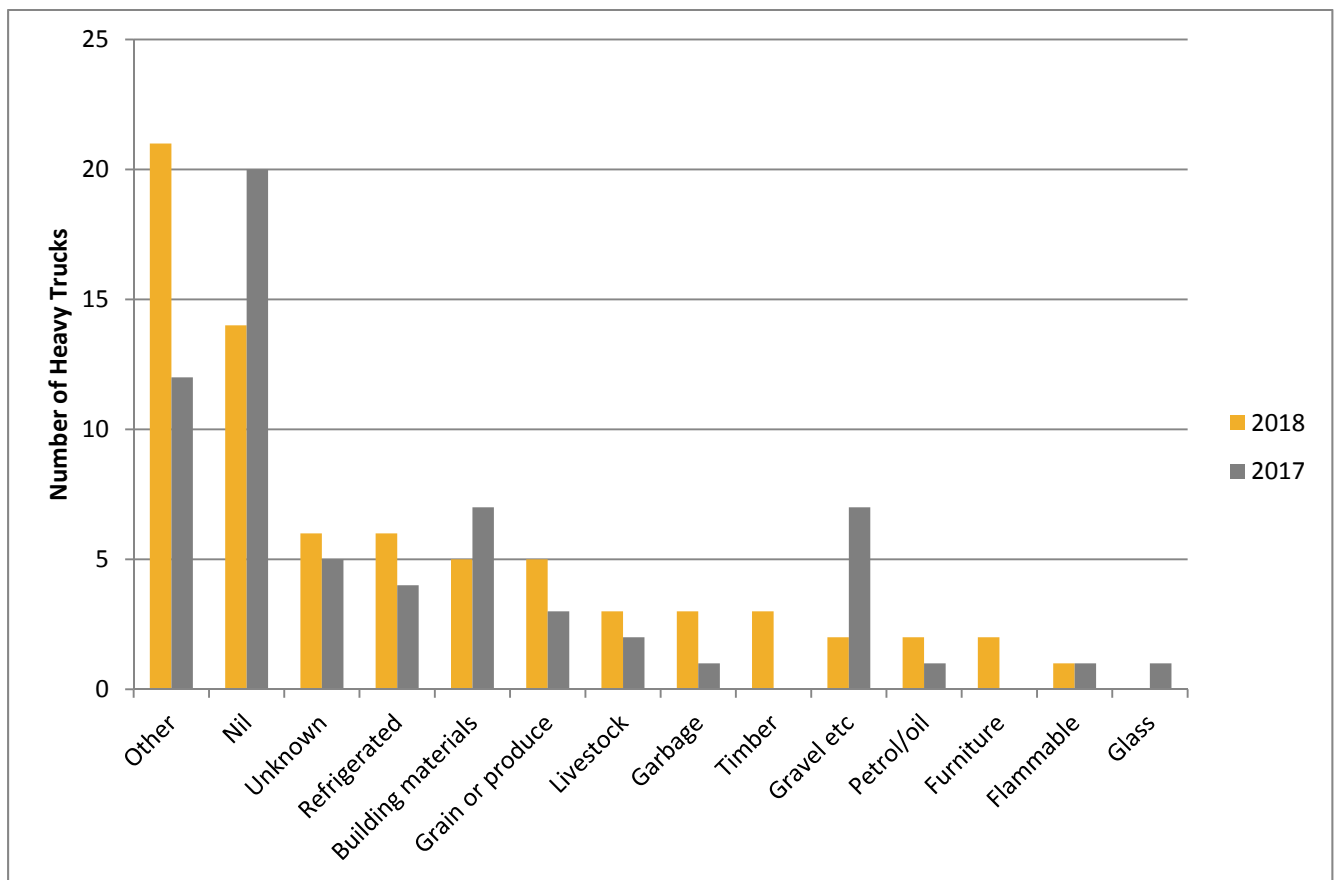

Definitions

Heavy Truck Crash

Any crash involving a Heavy Rigid Truck (rigid lorry and rigid tanker with a tare weight in excess of 4.5 tonnes) or an Articulated Truck (articulated tanker, semi-trailer, low loader, road train or B-double) on a road that results in death, injury or towed vehicle and is reported to the police.

Heavy Truck Fatality

A person who dies within 30 days from injuries received in a heavy truck crash
