The changes below are anticipated to take effect in the following two weeks.

Speed limits are set for all roads in NSW in accordance with the NSW Speed Zoning Guidelines. The changes outlined in the table below have been recommended following the completion and approval of a speed zone review by authorised speed zone officers.

This is advanced notice of a proposed speed limit change, however no change will occur until the relevant speed limit signs are changed.

Please ensure that you always observe the posted speed limit signs on the road.

Road name	From	To	Local Government Area	Current speed limit km/h	New speed limit km/h	Reason for change
Coraki Road, South Gundurimba	Bruxner Highway	700 metres west of Wyrallah Ferry Road	Lismore	100	80	This is a regional road and carries moderate traffic volumes. Previous crash history and the road geometry have been taken into consideration. The speed limit change is expected to improve safety for road users.
North Street, Kempsey	250 metres north east of Sea Street	Saleyards Road	Kempsey	70	60	This speed limit change better reflects recent development and improves safety for residents and road users.
Second Lane, Kempsey	Saleyards Road	260 metres east of Saleyards Road	Kempsey	70	60	As above
North Street, Kempsey	Armidale-Wollombi Road	250 metres north east of Sea Street	Kempsey	60	50	As above
