## Changes to permanent speed limits

The changes below are anticipated to take effect in the following two weeks.

Speed limits are set for all roads in NSW in accordance with the NSW Speed Zoning Guidelines. The changes outlined in the table below have been recommended following the completion and approval of a speed zone review by authorised speed zone officers.

This is advanced notice of a proposed speed limit change, however no change will occur until the relevant speed limit signs are changed.

**Please ensure that you always observe the posted speed limit signs on the road.**

Bells Line of Road, Bell	540 metres east of Darling Causeway	500 metres west of Mount Wilson Road	Hawkesbury	100	100 (Dry Weather) 80 (Wet Weather)	The introduction of a dual speed limit on Bells Line of Road between 540 metres east of Darling Causeway and 500 metres west of Mount Wilson Road is due to the number of wet weather crashes along this length. The wet weather speed limit change is expected to improve safety for residents and road users.
Campbelltown Road, St Andrews	80 metres north of Rose Payten Drive	Hume Highway	Campbelltown	70	80	This change reflects upgrades to the road which permit a higher speed limit and improved travel times.
