The changes below are anticipated to take effect in the following two weeks.

Speed limits are set for all roads in NSW in accordance with the NSW Speed Zoning Guidelines. The changes outlined in the table below have been recommended following the completion and approval of a speed zone review by authorised speed zone officers.

This is advanced notice of a proposed speed limit change, however no change will occur until the relevant speed limit signs are changed.

Please ensure that you always observe the posted speed limit signs on the road.

Road name	From	To	Local Government Area	Current speed limit km/h	New speed limit km/h	Reason for change
Mitchell Highway, North Bourke	100 metres south of the intersection with Hungerford Road	420 metres south of the intersection with Hungerford Road	Bourke	90	50	This change applies the 50km/h urban speed limit in accordance with NSW speed zoning guidelines. This speed limit change reflects the level of pedestrian activity and development at this location.
The Escort Way, Orange	80 metres west of Northern Distributor Road	620 metres west of Jonathon Road	Orange	80	60	This speed limit change better reflects recent development and improves safety for residents and road users.
