Drug driving puts you at risk of injuring or killing yourself, your friends or other people on NSW roads.

People react to drugs differently.

Having drugs in your system can make you less alert and reduce your ability to react to what's going on around you.

It can also put you under extreme pressure at a time when you should be focused on the task at hand - driving.

Remember:

- › MDT can occur anywhere, anytime and ANY police car could stop you for testing.
- › If you are caught with illegal drugs in your system, you could get hit with a fine, lose your licence and face severe consequences.
- › Police are just doing their job to keep you, your family and everyone else on our roads safe.
- › If you take illegal drugs and drive, you will get caught.
