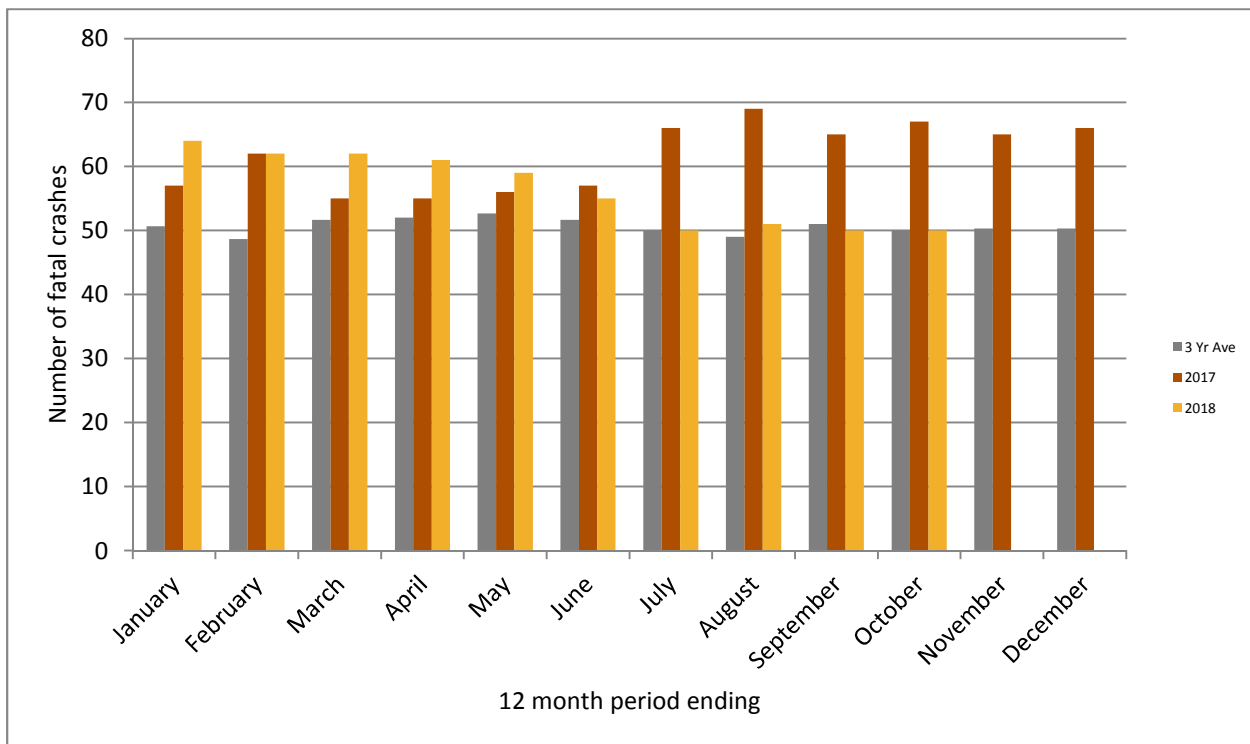


NSW heavy truck fatal crashes – as at 11 November 2018

Heavy truck fatal crashes, five years 2013 to 2017

- **266** fatal crashes involving heavy trucks, on average **53** fatal crashes per year
- **296** fatalities from heavy truck crashes, on average **59** people killed per year
- **6835** injuries from heavy truck crashes, on average **1367** injuries per year
- This includes **2015** serious injuries, on average **403** serious injuries per year

- **48** heavy truck fatal crashes, **20** less than the previous 12 months
- **55** fatalities from heavy truck crashes, **25** less than the previous 12 months

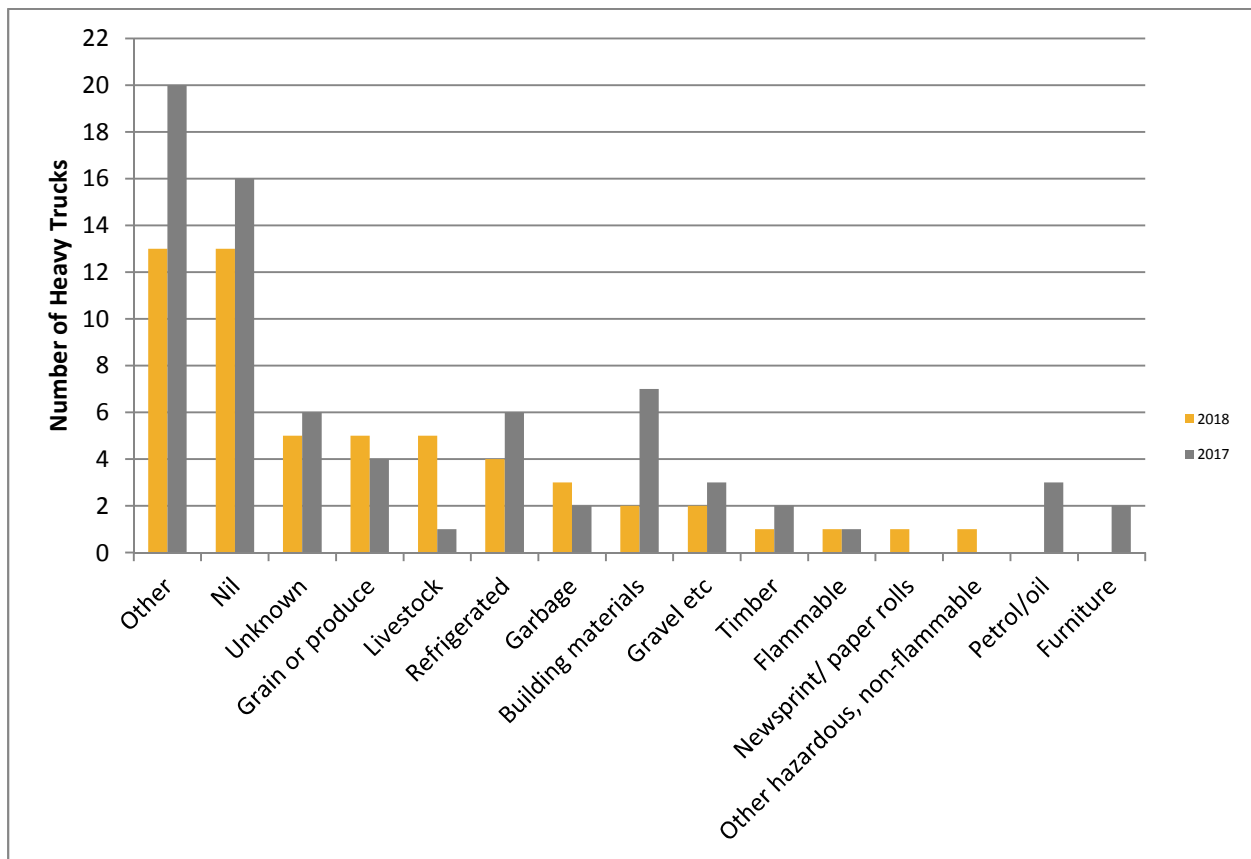

Definitions

Heavy Truck Crash

Any crash involving a Heavy Rigid Truck (rigid lorry and rigid tanker with a tare weight in excess of 4.5 tonnes) or an Articulated Truck (articulated tanker, semi-trailer, low loader, road train or B-double) on a road that results in death, injury or towed vehicle and is reported to the police.

Heavy Truck Fatality

A person who dies within 30 days from injuries received in a heavy truck crash
