Reason for change:

There are currently six speed limit changes along the 19 kilometre length of King Georges Road, Wiley Avenue, Roberts Road, Centenary Drive and Homebush Bay Drive.

The new speed zoning on this route will reduce the number of speed zones from six to four changes and provide improved consistency of speed zoning.

Before any speed limit changes take effect, information about the changes will appear in local press and/or signage notifications on site, and on the RTA website. Please observe current posted speed limits.

General information

The RTA has carried out a comprehensive review of King Georges Road, Wiley Avenue, Roberts Road, Centenary Drive and Homebush Bay Drive as part of the NSW Audit of Speed Zones. The speed limit review assessed a number of factors including road environment, traffic characteristics and crash profile.

- The 70 km/h speed limit on Centenary Drive will be extended by 1.6 kilometres north of its current location, reducing the speed limit from 80 km/h to 70 km/h from 540 metres south of Weeroona Road, Strathfield to 175 metres north of Norfolk Road, Greenacre.
- The 60 km/h speed limit on King Georges Road will be extended 760 metres north of its current location, reducing the speed limit from 70 km/h to 60 km/h from 460 metres north of Punchbowl Road, Greenacre to 190 metres north of Canterbury Road, Wiley Park.
- The speed limit on King Georges Road will be reduced from 70 km/h to 60 km/h from 190 metres north of Canterbury Road, Wiley Park to 200 metres north of Ponyara Road, Beverly Hills. This change will improve consistency of speed zoning, matching with adjacent speed zones.
- The speed limit on King Georges Road will be reduced from 70 km/h to 60 km/h from 100 metres south of Warwick Street, South Hurstville to 150 metres south of Connells Point Road, Blakehurst. This change will improve consistency of speed zoning, matching with adjacent speed zone.

The reduced speed limits will result in a maximum calculated increase in travel time of just 61 seconds when travelling between Homebush and Blakehurst.

These changes will help improve safety for all road users.
